WHAT TIME IS IT? TIME TO BE PART OF GOD'S PLAN!

Trust Walk

What you Need:

- Blindfolds
- Cups (or any other sort of objects to spread across the floor)

Build an obstacle course by spreading out the cups or other objects across the floor and designating a start and finish line. Have everyone partner up with one family member wearing the blindfold and the other family member being the helper. The object of the game is for the blindfolded person to make it across the obstacle course without stepping on any of the cups/objects. The helper will help their blindfolded partner get to the finish line by telling them which way to go. You can make it a competition/race to see which team finishes the obstacle course first. Just like the blindfolded person needed to trust their partner, we can trust God to help us when we ask.

Simon Says

Have one person be the leader and call out actions that the rest of the family has to do. The tricky part is that the family members can only follow the actions when the leader says, "Simon Says" beforehand. Switch up who the leader is and play multiple rounds! Sometimes standing up for the right thing can be difficult just like following the leader in this game, but with God's help we can stand up for right....NOW!

The Courageous Path

Designate the start line and finish line of the playing field, and assign one person to be the "king." The king will stand at the finish line and the rest of the family will stand at the starting line. The king will start with his back towards the rest of the family. When the game begins, the family can start to run towards the king, but when the king turns around everyone must freeze. If the King sees someone move, that person must go back to the starting line. The king will then turn his back to the rest of the family, and the family will run towards the king. This process will continue until someone reaches the king. Switch up who is the king and play as many times as you want. The path Esther had to take towards the king took a lot of courage, and we need to be courageous if we are going to walk on the path God has for us!
