GOD LOVES ME... and CHOOSES ME!

I am Chosen!

What You Need:

- A cut out hearts

Have everyone in the family line up from youngest to oldest. Give a heart to the person that is the youngest in the line. Then have everyone in the family line up from shortest to tallest. Give a heart to the shortest person in the line. Then have everyone line up by shoe size. Give a heart to the person with the smallest feet. You can come up with your own categories (who can run the fastest, who can jump higher, ect...) While the world may look at things like how tall you are or how fast you can run, God sees you and chooses you because of your heart!

Table Talk Questions

1. How was David different from his brothers?
2. Why did God choose David to be King?
3. What does God look at when He chooses us?
4. What in our heart is important to God?

CIRCLE CHOOSING

Have everyone in the family sit in a circle.

Appoint one leader to stand in the middle of the circle and say, "I choose everyone wearing red to run around the circle" and all those who are wearing red will jump up and run around the circle one time and sit down. The leader can continue to CHOOSE during this game, saying those with brown eyes are chosen, or those who have traveled out of the state, or those who like dogs, or those who like chocolate ice cream, ect... Each time those who are chosen will run around the circle. Because God chooses us we get to do what He has planned for us just like David did when he was king.

What's On my Forehead?

What you need:

- Sticky notes with different professions written on them (teacher, police officer, waiter, chef, grocery store employee, ceo, ect...)

Have everyone stick a sticky note to their forehead without looking at what is on it. Then everyone in the family can interact with each other and can ask each other questions. Try to figure out what profession you are through the way others interact with you. In this game, people looked what you are on the outside, and while that is important, God loves you and chooses you for your heart.
