

God Promises Us Faithfulness

Lean on ME!

Divide the family into groups of 4 or 6 – it must be an even number. Ask each group to stand in a circle holding hands or holding wrists to make it stronger, and count off in order, one, two, one, two, etc. The "ones" will lean forward when the "two's" lean back when you tell them to. Hold on tightly so that you can support each other from falling. Then, try reversing, so that the ones leaning forward will lean backward and the ones leaning backward will lean forward. For younger family members, you may wish to start with one group, with the rest of the family members watching. Then, organize a second circle to do the same. This way, adults and remaining family members can stand around the circle to make sure nobody falls. Just like you supported each other in the circle, God will support you with his faithfulness. He always keeps His promises!

Link up Tag!

Find a space that is big enough to run around in. Designate one person to be "it" and try to tag other family members. When a family member is tagged, they must link their arm with the tagger and join them in tagging other people. Keep playing until all family members are linked up. Faithfulness means sticking beside other people just like we did in this game! God is always faithful and He is always with us!

Trust Fall!

Have each family member take a turn falling backwards while the other family members catch him or her. God will always catch us when we fall because he is faithful!
